JOB OVERVIEW

The Electrical Field Supervisor is responsible for aiding other Wescom leaders in developing, tracking, and achieving Permian electrical division goals. This includes discussions with the operation president of the affected division to accurately plan resources, costs, and schedules in response to proposal requests. Coordinate information requests, submittals, drawings, resource allocations, and other necessary methods to ensure quality installations from start to finish. All employees must act with urgency, accountability, and flexibility to ensure Wescom's core values are always followed.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Assist Managers in finding and determining good fit projects for the entire team.
- Prompt responses to proposal requests through accurate planning of resources, costs, and schedules, and coordination with operations presidents of affected divisions.
